## **PSC Offers New Search Features for Orders and Formal Cases**

In anticipation of the Commission's Centennial Anniversary on March 4, 2013, the Commission announces the posting of a new Index of Formal Cases and an Index of Orders in the Commission's eDocket system.

These two Indexes contain all formal cases and orders dating back to 1913, when the Commission was first established. EDocket is the Commission's electronic formal case filing system that provides the public with 24/7 access to the official filings and records maintained by the Office of the Commission Secretary. The Index of Formal Cases has 1,097 entries and the Index of Orders contains over 16,750 entries. Moreover, each formal case caption and each order title is linked to the formal case and order so the user can access the documents directly from the Index.

The Index of Formal Cases (<a href="http://dcpsc.org/edocket/fc\_search.asp">http://dcpsc.org/edocket/fc\_search.asp</a>) can be searched by utilizing any of the following attributes:

- Formal Case Number
- Keywords (regulations, application, rates, underground transmission, etc.)
- Date Range

- Order Number
- Keywords (regulations, application, rates, underground transmission, etc.)
