Did You Know?

All residential, commercial, and government customers can:

- CHOOSE among Pepco & several alternative electric generation and transmission suppliers,
- CHOOSE among Washington Gas & several alternative commodity natural gas suppliers, and
- CHOOSE among Verizon & several local telephone service providers (also known as Competitive Local Exchange Carriers/ CLECs).

Why Choose?







Many customers are choosing because:

- · They may find a supplier that provides significant savings,
- The electricity supplier uses primarily renewable energy, or
- The provider might offer other value-added benefits such as appliance repairs.

District residents should be aware of the following:

- You can choose your electric generation and transmission supplier.
 However, Pepco remains the sole electric distribution company.
- You can choose your commodity gas supplier while Washington Gas Light (WGL) remains the sole natural gas distribution company. Commodity gas suppliers own the gas that flows through WGL's local delivery system of mains and pipes.
- You can choose your local telephone service provider, and bundle local service with various combinations of long distance, cable television, and Internet services, depending on which provider you select.

The following pages will assist you in researching and comparing suppli-

ers to decide if a new supplier is right for you. Once you have decided which supplier and offer is right for you, contact the supplier you have chosen to make the switch.

Here are Questions to Ask Electric Generation and Transmission Suppliers:

- 1. How much are your generation and transmission charges?

 (A generation charge is the cost to produce electricity at power plants. A transmission charge is the cost to deliver electricity over power lines from generation companies to Pepco. When shopping for a supplier, compare the prices to determine which supplier is best for you.)
- 2. Do I have to sign a contract? What are the terms and conditions for the contract? Are there cancellation fees?
- 3. Are renewable resources used in generating the electricity you sell, and to what extent?
- 4. Is there a payment plan? If I am already on a payment plan or utility discount plan, will it continue with the new supplier?
- 5. Will I be billed by Pepco or the alternative supplier? How often will I be billed?

(Currently, Pepco prepares all monthly bills and the generation suppliers costs are shown on the Pepco bill.)

Here are Questions to Ask Commodity Natural Gas Suppliers:

- 1. How much is the charge for your natural gas supply service, and does your price include a balancing charge? Is the balancing charge fixed and for how long? Or, if variable, what is it based upon?
 - (The natural gas supply service charge is the cost of the commodity natural gas. WGL's commodity gas rate that appears on consumers' bills is called the Purchased Gas Charge (PGC). This charge is market-based. Review the trend in wholesale natural gas prices. Each year, suppliers pay a different price for natural gas due to supply and the economy.
 - A balancing charge is the cost to match the amount of natural gas supplied by WGL with the amount of natural gas actually consumed by customers.)
- 2. Do I have to sign a contract? What are the terms and conditions for the contract? Are there cancellation fees?
- 3. Is there a payment plan? If I am already on a payment plan or utility discount plan, will it continue with the new supplier?
- 4. Will I be billed by WGL or the alternative supplier? How often will I be billed?

(Currently, WGL prepares all monthly bills and the commodity gas supplier's costs are shown in the WGL bill.)
